*COMM 1024 is equivalent to COMM 1016 - if you have successfully completed COMM 1016 or received a transfer credit for COMM 1016, or a COMM 9000 - Please do not register for COMM 1024 as it will not count as a second level 1 COMM requirement towards your Program.

**COMM 2025 is equivalent to COMM 2017 - if you have successfully completed COMM 2017 or received a transfer credit for COMM 2017 - Please do not register for COMM 2025 as it will not count as a second COMM credit towards your Program requirements.

(ODE) in the course title - refers to Ontario Distance Education (OntarioLearn) courses. These are not delivered by Georgian, therefore COMM and GNED office is unable to support you with any technical needs or academic appeals with these courses. **They come with an added cost. You will receive an email from the OntarioLearn office at Georgian (ol@georgiancollege.ca) after you register with instructions on how to access your course and additional details.** They are not through Blackboard, and grades may be delayed (if you are in a program that requires grades for Board exams, please check with the Reg. Office if timing of this course is acceptable to meet those deadlines).

Please refer to MyPath, or seek advice from a student advisor, Coordinator, Registrars office, or liberal.arts@georgiancollege.ca if you have taken courses previously at Georgian (or OntarioLearn) to ensure you are not taking the same COMM course again (Course codes may be different, but equivalent).
